Ticket prices vary depending on where in the stadium you choose to sit; concession prices are available.

Ticket Office

The ticket office is located in between the Stan Cullis and Billy Wright stands, opening on all home matchdays up until half-time. Opening times vary depending on kick-off time, please consult the official website ahead of the game for accurate timings.

Accessible Ticketing

Accessible tickets are sold at the appropriate age band for the stand you are watching the game from and we offer a complimentary PA/Companion ticket for eligible supporters.

To qualify for a complimentary PA/Companion ticket, we will need to see a copy of your supporting documentation by way of middle to higher level DLA award letter or normal to enhanced level PIP award letter. In some circumstances we would accept a letter from your GP or hospital, but these requests will be subject to approval by the club.

Ticket Information

Tickets will be sent as paper tickets through the post.

Supporters who have chosen to receive an e-ticket will be able to scan the QR code at the turnstiles or can print the e-ticket at home to bring with them.

Reprints

Reprints will be available on the day from the Box Office, where possible we ask that you notify in advance by emailing ticketoffice@wolves.co.uk quoting "Conti Cup Reprint" in the subject field. Please remember to bring ID in order to obtain your duplicate ticket.

Cashless

Molineux is a cashless stadium and only card payments will be accepted.



GETTING TO MOLINEUX

We strongly recommend that fans take advantage of public transport, and walking or cycling travel modes when travelling to the match at Molineux Stadium. Up to date travel information will be published on our Fan Services Twitter page @WolvesHelp. We liaise with key local and national travel networks and can provide up to date information ahead of your visit: @TransportForWM @WestMidRailway @nxwestmidlands @WMmetro.

BY RAIL

There is **significant disruption on the rail network** on matchday due to planned engineering works.

If you are travelling to Molineux Stadium from London, please be advised that there are no West Coast Mainline services running to / from London Euston. If you intend to travel by rail, please be mindful of diversionary routes in place and additional travel times required to make your journey. Please plan your journey in advance of matchday – all of the latest rail travel guidance can be found on the National Rail website.



BY COACH

Spectators can also book individual coach travel via the National Express website, which offers point to point services from across the UK for spectators travelling to Wolverhampton for the match.

Due to rail disruption from London, please check out the National Express Events page for matchday coach services direct to Molineux Stadium.



PARK & WALK

Park & Walk is available at the Wolverhampton Racecourse, just a 20-minute walk to the stadium, with ample space. All parking must be booked in advance – please check out the link HERE.



No on-the-day parking will be available.

BY CAR

Parking

If you intend to drive to the stadium, please allow for plenty of time for your journey and make sure to plan your journey in advance.

There is no general spectator parking available at Molineux Stadium. There is a limited amount of on-site accessible parking available which must be booked directly through the Wolverhampton Wanderers Fan Services team. Please contact <code>fanservices@wolves.co.uk</code> or 01902810485 to book your accessible space.

Molineux stadium benefits from being in close proximity to Wolverhampton's city centre. There are many city centre car parks available on matchday – please check out Wolverhampton City Council's dedicated webpage for more information.



By road from the north

Exit M6 at junction 12.

At island take third exit onto A5 for Wolverhampton.

At the next island turn left onto A449. After six miles the A449 passes under the M54.

Carry straight on and at the sixth island (Five Ways) take the third exit onto Waterloo Road. Molineux is one mile straight on.

By road from the south east

Exit M6 at junction 10.

Take A454 via Willenhall to Wolverhampton Ring Road. At first Ring Road island, take the fourth exit (A449 to Stafford).

Straight on at next two sets of traffic lights.

Filter right at third set of lights into Waterloo Road.

Molineux is 500 yards on the right.

By road from the south west

Exit M5 at junction 2.

Follow the signs for Wolverhampton on the A4123 for eight miles to the Ring Road.

Turn left on Ring Road, following signs for Molineux.

Take second exit at next two islands, pass Banks's Brewery and swimming baths on left and then turn left at next set of traffic lights.

Molineux is 500 yards on the right.

Road Closures

A number of road closures around the stadium as part of spectator safety measures will affect supporters on matchdays.

Please refer to the road closure map on the following opposite and information below for details.

Waterloo Road


Will be closed from the roundabout leading to ASDA up to the traffic lights at Newhampton Road from 90 minutes before kick-off up until a period at the discretion of the Matchday Safety Officer at the end of the game. (expected to be between 15 and 30 minutes).

Molineux Street / Sir Jack Hayward Way

These roads will be closed as detailed on the map from one hour before kick-off up until a period at the discretion of the Matchday Safety Officer at the end of the game (expected to be between 15 and 30 minutes).

Whitmore Hill

Whitmore Hill closes 30 minutes prior to kick-off.





ACCESSIBILITY

Wolves are committed to providing services and facilities for supporters with accessibility requirements.

Audio Descriptive Commentary

Audio Descriptive Commentary is available throughout the stadium for supporters who are partially sighted or blind. Anyone wishing to use the audio descriptive commentary service should pre-book through the Fan Services team on fanservices@wolves.co.uk.

Sensory Room

Wolves has a dedicated Sensory Room for use on matchdays. Supporters with neurodiverse conditions such as autism and other sensory conditions can book this room on a match-by match basis or use during the match when the need arises (subject to availability). 

The map below shows matchday food availability inside the Stadium.


Concourse catering kiosks will be open inside the stadium for this fixture serving food hot and cold drinks and alcoholic drinks. Molineux is a cashless stadium and supporters are advised to ensure they have card or contactless payment ready when being served.

We have a wide range of food options available, with both vegan and vegetarian alternatives provided.

If you have any allergies or intolerances, we have QR codes set up around the concourse areas which can be scanned with further information provided on allergens throughout all the products that are available.

We also have lower accessible counters on catering kiosks across the Stan Cullis stand

Dedicated stewards are available to assist in all accessible areas of the ground.

Download the Wolves App -

this contains lots of important and useful information for your visit to Molineux.

Follow@WolvesHelp on X -

where all up-to-date information on and before a matchday will be published.

Ensure you have your tickets -

for the fixture before leaving home.

Check the travel information or route -

prior to leaving. We advise considering public transport use.

Ensure you have your car park pre-booked -

(if arriving by car) or familiarise yourself with local city centre car parks that can be used.

Plan a walking or bus route -

(where applicable) to the stadium from the city centre. Molineux is signposted around the city too.

Think about taking in some of the atmosphere around the ground -

The Fan Zone opens around three hours prior to kick-off. The Megastore and Ticket Office will also be open from 9am until kick-off.

Check the turnstile you will need to enter this is printed on the ticket.

Scan your ticket -

at the turnstile.

Take a look at the food and drink options -

available, in the concourse there are various options at the kiosks/bars.

Take your seat around 30minutes prior to kick-off -

and enjoy the pre-match build up and entertainment.

Enjoy the game -

please ensure any litter is discarded in the bins located in the concourse.

Leave the stadium safely -

through the designated exits. Remember that traffic congestion away from the city is extremely busy following final whistle. Road closures will also be lifted around 30minutes prior to the end of the game.

Have a safe journey home -

and we hope to welcome you back to Molineux soon!

KEY INFORMATION

Bag policy

Supporters can only bring a bag smaller than A4 size into the stadium, subject to a full search at the turnstiles.

Unfortunately, there is no facility for storing bags or luggage at Molineux. Supporters are advised are not to travel to the stadium with luggage.

Babes in arms

Wolves recommend that fans do not bring babies in arms to football matches as it can be very noisy. In accordance with the Stadium Safety Certificate and relevant legislation, all fans, regardless of age, require a valid match ticket.

All children attending, regardless of age, will need a valid matchday ticket.

Under-14s

Supporters aged 14 or under must be accompanied by an adult aged 18 or over.

Molineux does not have a specific meeting point. When arriving at the venue it is recommended that you pre-arrange a meeting location with your party in the event your group gets split up or anyone gets lost. In the event of this occurring please contact the nearest steward for assistance.

Pushchairs/buggies

Pushchairs and buggies are not allowed into the stadium. Babies must be securely strapped to their parent or carer by way of a baby carrier, sling, papoose or similar.

Baby changing facilities

There are no baby changing facilities at Molineux.

Flags & banners

Flags and banners are permitted inside the stadium providing they are no larger than 150cm at their widest or longest section, permission from the club must be granted for flags larger than 150cm in size. The obstruction of gangways, access & exit routes, entrances, signage, and stairways is prohibited.

Turnstile searches

Supporters will be searched at the turnstile prior to entering the stadium. No searching will be carried out on children (U14) unless there is a specific threat to the safety of others and then only with the child's permission and if possible, with a parent or carer present.

Smoking/vaping

Smoking and vaping is not permitted inside Molineux, this includes both the stadium bowl and concourse areas.

ATMs

ATMs can be found at Asda which is a 1-minute walk from the Stan Cullis stand. Please note that Molineux is a cashless stadium.

Matchday programme

Matchday programmes can be purchased from programme sellers located at various points around the stadium.

Food & drink

Several food and drink options are available at locations around the stadium and inside of the stadium.

ABUSE AND ANTISOCIAL BEHAVIOUR

Discriminatory behaviour of any kind will not be tolerated at Molineux. The club's commitment is to promote inclusion and to confront and eliminate discrimination whether by reason of age, gender, gender reassignment, sexual orientation, race, marital status or civil partnership, race, nationality, ethnic origin, religion or belief, ability or disability, pregnancy and maternity and to encourage equal opportunities.

If you witness any act of hate, discrimination or abusive behaviour at Molineux, you can confidentially report it by the following methods.

- Text 07723 479887 and start your message with the word WOLVES

Once an incident has been reported, it will be logged and fed back to the stadium control room. The area will then be monitored on CCTV and stewards in the area will be notified. In some instances, it will not always be possible for the club to take visible action straight away.

However, supporters should be assured that incidents will be logged and be monitored even if there is no visual indication that this is happening.

Having reported an incident using the text message reporting service, supporters may receive a reply from the club asking them for further information or providing further instructions.
