MATCHDAY KEY INFO

BAG POLICY

Bags must be no larger than 45cm x 30cm x 15cm and are subject to search. There is no on-site storage facility for oversized bags. However, if you have a medical condition that requires you to bring a bag or other equipment, please email slo@dcfc.co.uk.

Supporters are prohibited from bringing refreshments into Pride Park Stadium. However, if a supporter has specific dietary or sustenance requirements because of a medical condition, please contact us by calling 0871 472 1884 in advance of attending the game.

MEDICATION

To bring essential medication into the stadium, please email slo@dcfc.co.uk or call 0133 266 7528 with details of the medication and support you may require.

FLAG POLICY

Derby County wants an exciting atmosphere at all home games at Pride Park Stadium and encourages all fans to bring flags, banners, and large 'Surfing' flags - but these must adhere to the guidelines set by the club in tandem with the stadium's safety team. CASHLESS

Pride Park Stadium is a cashless venue. Please be aware that NO kiosks will accept cash; we can only accept contactless & card payments.

GETTING TO PRIDE PARK

LOOK OUT FOR OUR TEAM ON THE ROUTE TO DIRECT YOU WHERE YOU NEED TO GO!



Please be aware that there is disruption on the rail network on matchday between London and Derby due to planned engineering works.

If you are travelling to Pride Park Stadium from London, please be advised that there are no direct East Midland Railway services running to / from London. If you intend to travel by rail, please be mindful of diversionary routes in place and additional travel times required to make your journey.

CrossCountry and East Midland Railway services to / from Manchester are unaffected and there is a good service on matchday. Derby rail station is the closest station to the stadium for those arriving by train – just a 20-minute walk away!

Please plan your journey in advance – all of the latest rail travel guidance can be found on the National Rail website.

Walk the route from the train station to the stadium and join us in bringing the vintage vibes. See our showcase of vintage shirts on display and hear your favourite anthems, chants, and pump-up songs. Vintage shirts aren't just a classic; they're the ultimate comeback queens. 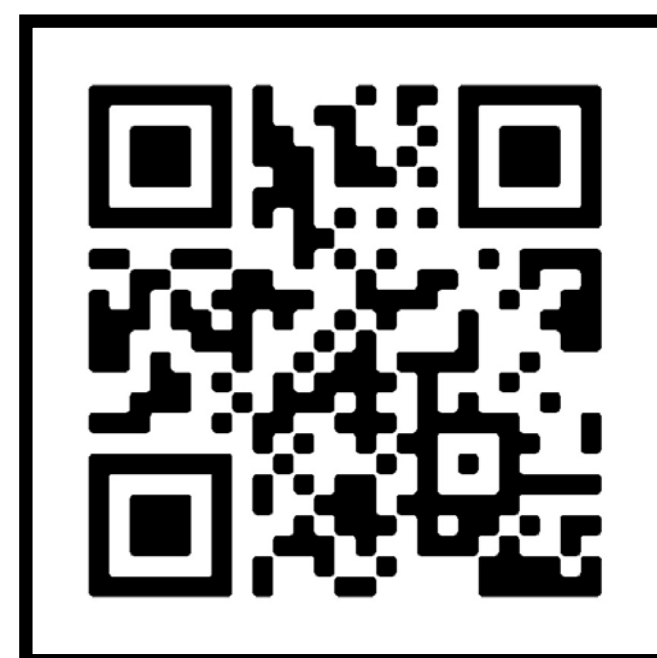

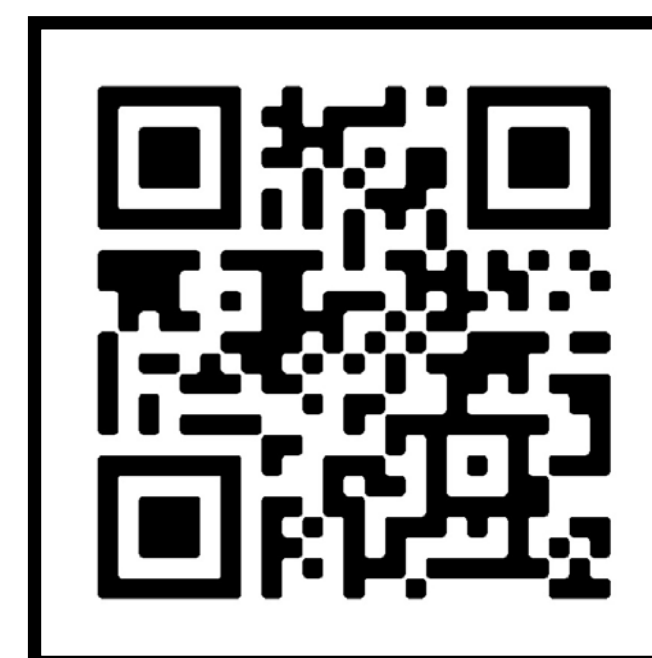


QR code providing driving directions to Bold Lane Car Park from person's current location.

QR code providing driving directions to Chapel Street Car Park from person's current location.

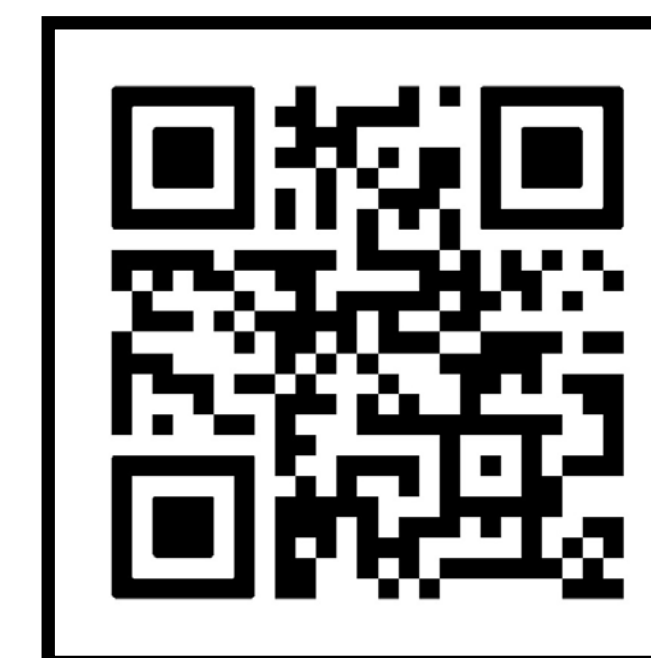

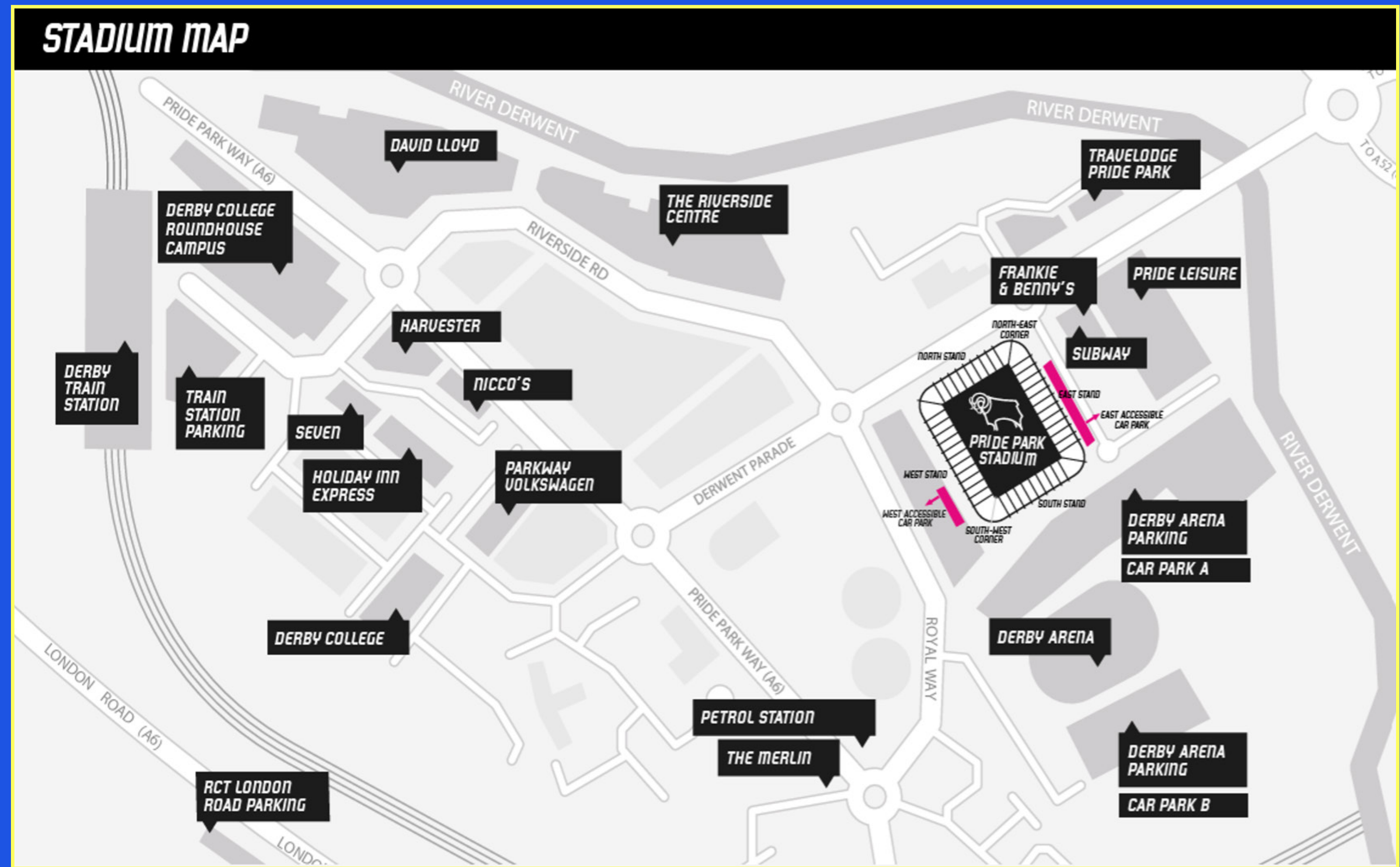

TRAFFIC EXCLUSION

In the interest of pedestrian safety, a traffic exclusion zone is imposed around Pride Park Stadium on matchdays to exclude vehicles along Royal Way and Derwent Parade. Please see map (below) for more information. The zone is in operation from 90 minutes prior to kick off to approximately 30-60 minutes after the final whistle. The precise timing is dependent upon traffic and pedestrian movement on the affected roads. Resident parking zones are in operation on matchdays. We strongly advise all supporters to use official car parks and avoid parking in residential areas. You will avoid the parking fine of £60 which you will incur for parking in within the residents' zones.



MATCHDAY FIRST AID

We have two St John's Ambulance medical rooms available on a matchday; one is in the North-West corner of the lower concourse and the other is in the South-West corner of the lower concourse.

If a supporter becomes unwell at Pride Park Stadium and requires medical assistance, then we strongly advise that the nearest steward is made aware who will ensure that the crowd medical team is notified, and that appropriate care is provided. It is important to note that the responsibilities of the crowd medical teams are separate to club medical support teams for players.

The defibrillator is located within the Security Office, next to the player's entrance on the west side of the stadium.

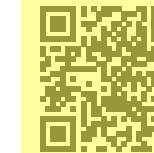

ENTERING THE STADIUM

ENTERING THE STADIUM

To ensure that you are able to enter Pride Park Stadium without any issues, it is important that you attempt to access the stadium using the correct turnstile; the turnstile that you should be using will be displayed clearly on your match ticket.

Match Ticket must be used at the correct turnstile (accessible entrances are available in all four stands to those disabled supporters that require to use one and are clearly signed).

RE-ADMITTANCE

There is no re-admittance to the stadium if you leave prior to the end of the fixture. We do however make allowances for smoking within a specific cordoned area. For further information on where to go to smoke please speak to our stewarding team who can direct you accordingly

HELP OR ASSISTANCE NEEDED?

If you need assistance in finding your way around Pride Park Stadium there are a number of outlets of information available to you.

Firstly, our stewarding team are strategically located in their high visibility uniforms on hand to give assistance with any questions which you may have, they have a high knowledge of local amenities and stadium access; if they do not know a piece of information, they will endeavour to find someone that does.

Our designated Matchday Supporter Liaison Officers will also be on hand to deal with any of your queries too; look for their blue 'Fans First' jacket!

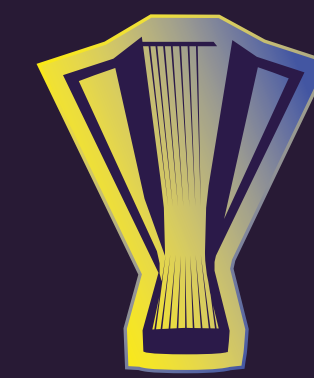

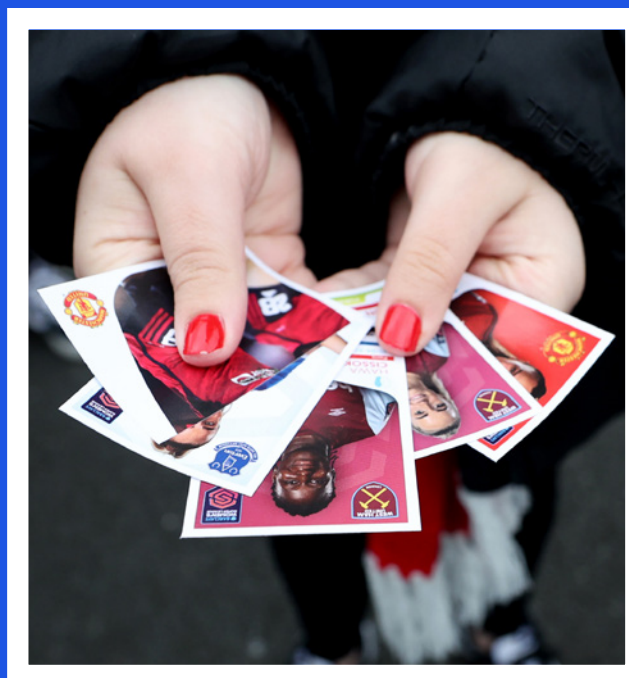

ACCESSIBILITY

We are pleased to host the Women's League Cup Final at Pride Park Stadium and we are committed to ensuring an inclusive and accessible experience for all supporters.

COMPLIMENTARY PERSONAL ASSISTANT TICKETS

Supporters with access requirements may be entitled to a complimentary Personal Assistant ticket. These tickets are allocated in line with the respective club's policies.

ACCESSIBLE PARKING

Blue Badge holders can reserve accessible parking spaces by calling our Accessibility Team on 0133 266 7528, no later than 24 hours before the fixture.

TRANSPORTATION

A free shuttle service using buggies is available to transport supporters needing assistance from our onsite Car Parks (excluding Car Park B) and around the stadium perimeter. This service operates up to kick-off and resumes after the final whistle, with possible brief suspensions due to congestion for safety reasons.

ACCESSIBLE ENTRANCES

Clearly signed accessible entrances are available in all four stands. Stewards are on hand to provide assistance, as needed.

ACCESSIBLE TOILETS

Accessible toilets, operating with a radar key system, are located in all stands. Supporters are advised to bring their own radar key.

ACCESSIBLE SEATING/ WHEELCHAIR USER SPACES

We offer various seating options for supporters with access requirements.

- Easy Access Seating: Available on Row AA (no steps), Row BB (1 step), Row CC (2 steps).
- Wheelchair Spaces: A choice of pitch-side & and platform wheelchair user spaces are available.

Ambulant supporters not requiring accessible seating may sit anywhere in their designated stand, with their Personal Assistant (subject to qualification), providing they can safely access their seat.

ACCESSIBILITY

ASSISTANCE DOGS

Supporters intending to bring assistance dogs should contact Emma Drury at emma.drury@dcfc.co.uk or call 0133 266 7528 to ensure suitable seating and arrangements are made.

AUDIO DESCRIPTIVE COMMENTARY

An audio descriptive commentary service is available for blind or partially sighted supporters. To reserve a receiver, supporters should call our Accessibility Team on 0133 266 7528 no later than 24 hours before the fixture. Please note, supporters need to bring their own earphones (round jack).

SENSORY ROOMS

Our sensory rooms provide a calm environment for supporters who may find the stadium experience overwhelming. Operated by the Derby County Community Trust, these rooms are especially beneficial for individuals with

sensory processing challenges. Supporters should book via the Derby County Community Trust website in advance to ensure availability (link below).

Trained stewards are available to assist supporters with access requirements upon arrival at Pride Park Stadium, providing help with directions, seating access, and other needs.

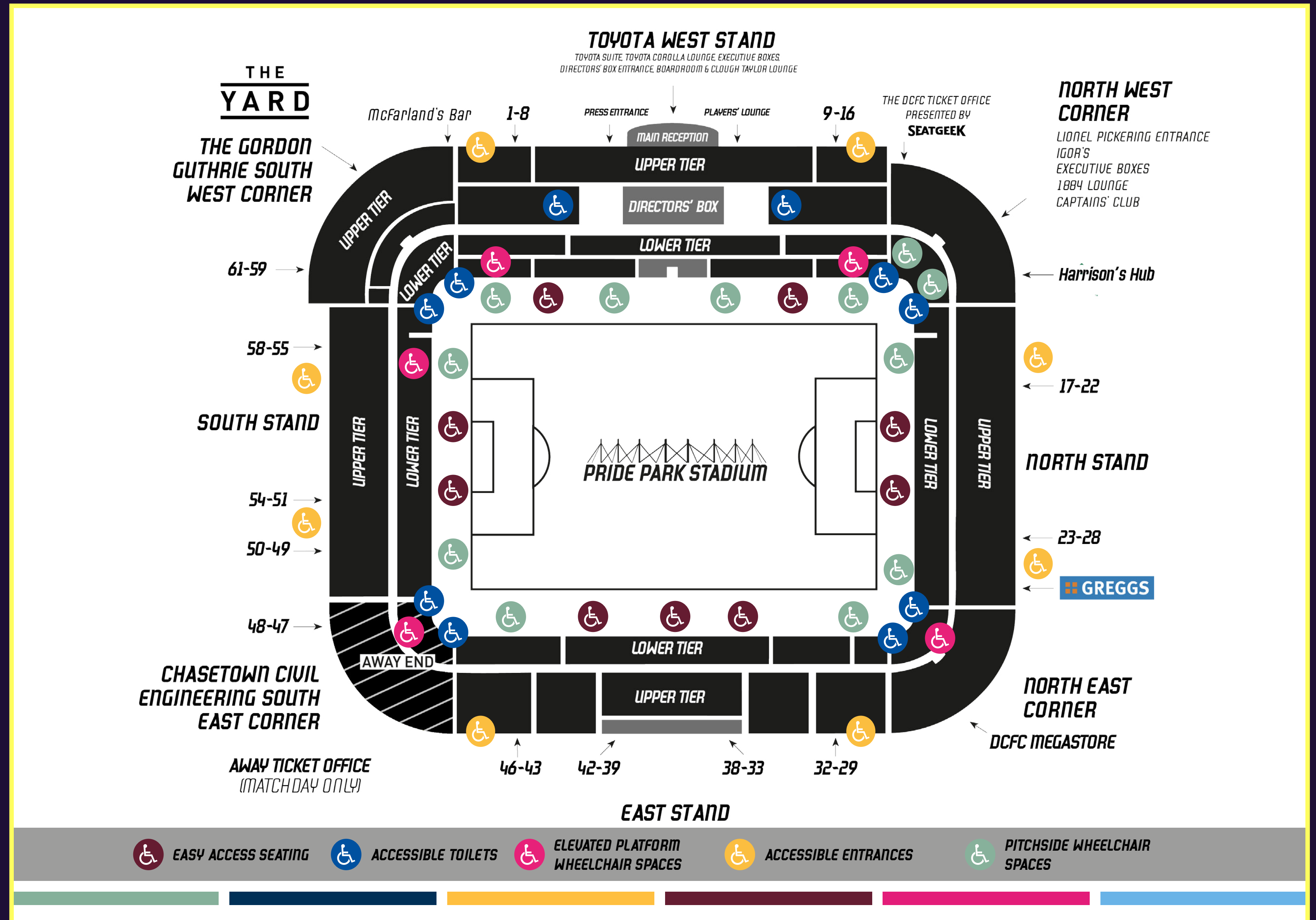

ABUSE AND ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR

REPORTING AN INCIDENT/ CONCERN

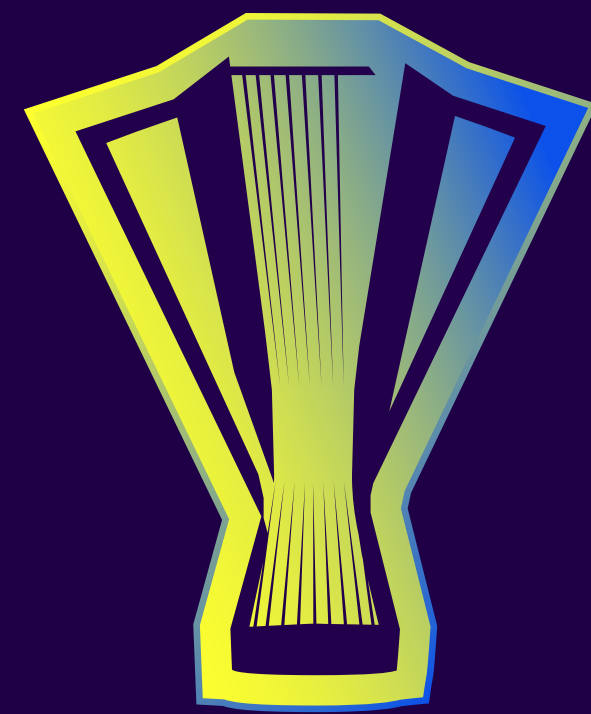
We recognise that most supporters come to the stadium to watch a football match and not to listen to abusive or indecent language from the stands. Swearing in the dedicated Family area (northwest corner) is not acceptable

Discriminatory behaviour, which includes, shouting, chanting or actions such as racist, sectarian, homophobic, sexist, or anti-disability behaviour, is unacceptable. If you witness incidents like these please get in contact with a steward as soon as you can and report your concerns as this will enable us to act on them as quickly as possible.

MATCHDAY TEXT SERVICE

Whilst it is a rare occurrence at Pride Park Stadium, there are times when the behaviour of other fans may be regarded as unacceptable, you can report directly to Derby County Match Control through our matchday text service, by starting your text with DCFC then type your message to 88440.

Please include as much information as possible including the Stand, Row, and Seat details of where the incident occurred. Your text will be treated in the strictest of confidence as we identify and deal with the perpetrators.
